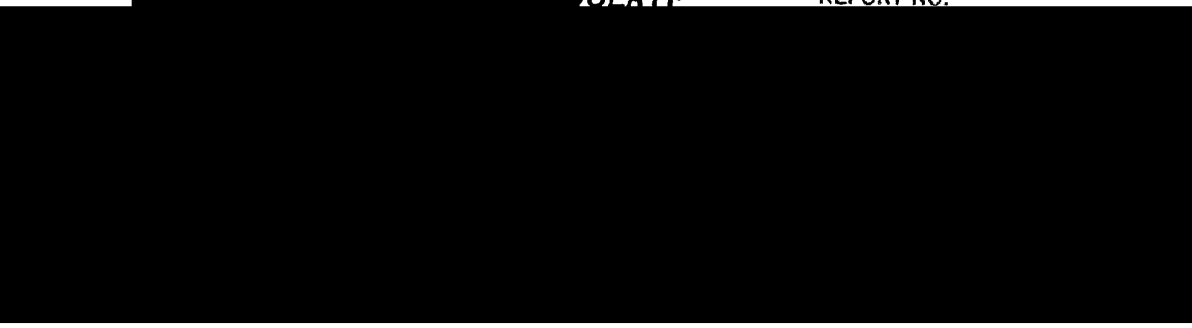

1. On 20 September, there was about 1 division of troops in the Ch'ongjin (129-49, 41-47) (EB 6826) area. On the nights of 18 and 19 September, guns with long barrels were being fired in this area.
2. Between 40 and 80 sailboats were moved out of Ch'ongjin harbor on the night of 15 August. According to a marine products company employee, the boats carried soldiers and mines.
3. On 20 September, serviceable airfields in the Ch'ongjin area were at Hoemun (129-39, 41-27) (EA 5488) and Songp'ong, Ch'ongjin.
4. A United Nations bombing of Najin on 26 August was very effective, particularly in the area of the Najin station, where 10 freight cars were destroyed. There was a large number of sailors in the city about the same time.

1. [REDACTED] Comment. The nationality of the troops was unstated, but another source who has access to the same information reported that a large force of Chinese Communists entered the Ch'ongjin area in early September;
