1. Prior to 31 August 1951, the Panzer Kaserne in Bad Freienwalde (N 53/V 23) still quartered a rear unit of 120 to 150 troops who wore red-bordered black epaulets, including some with motor transport, tank and artillery insignia. No training activity was noticed.

2. Troop trains which were seen passing through Bad Freienwalde from the direction of Eberswalde included a train with 8 rocket launchers, 2 field kitchens and about 16 trucks on 26 August; and a train with 8 rocket launchers, 2 field kitchens and an undetermined number of trucks on 30 August. **

25X1A * **Comment.** The information indicates no changes in the military situation at Bad Freienwalde since a report of 2 August 1951 by the same and another source.

25X1A** **Comment.** The trains probably carried components of the 312th Gds R. Regt of the Fourth Gds Recz Army. The loading of the first train was previously reported from Eberswalde by another source. See . The direction of the movement, as stated in the present report, indicates that the trains went to the Lieberose troop training grounds where components of the regiment seemed to have also practiced in July 1951.
