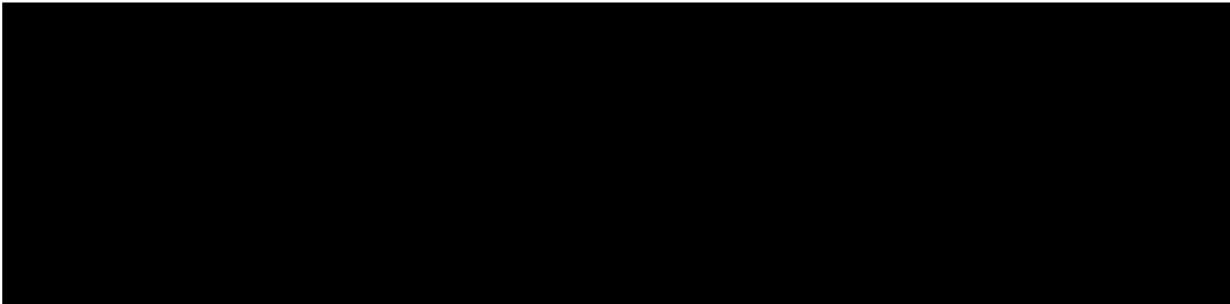

1. About 2.5 kilometers south of the road leading from the railroad station at Bodenhagen* to Neu Tramm (055/114), and about equidistant from the two points, there is a concealed munitions factory which since the war has been entirely under Soviet control. Smoke seen in the area in May and June 1951 indicated that the factory was in operation.
2. Many Soviet sentries are stationed at various points in the forest, and entrance to the areas guarded by them is forbidden.

[REDACTED] Comment: After the war, Bodenhagen was given the name Podczele, and was later renamed Bagicz. The road from the Bodenhagen railroad station to Neu Tramm is indicated on the map as being only a small road, but it is in reality a main road. The forest south of Bodenhagen is also traversed by many first-class roads.
