REMARKS

1. In the afternoon of 28 August 1951, there was moderate 50X1-HUM flying activity at Neubrandenburg-Trollenhagen airfield. 50X1-HUM there had been intensive 50X1-HUM flying by MiG-15s during the morning. The planes practiced attacks on ground targets 1 km north of Neddemin. 50X1-HUM the fighters approached the targets 50X1-HUM individually, in groups of two or in flights, flying one 50X1-HUM after the other, and after diving from an altitude of about 400 meters at approximately a 45 degree angle fired from an altitude of about 50 meters. Thereupon they climbed at about a 45 degree angle. A ground detail which fired signal lights and sent smoke signals was observed at a point about 200 meters from the targets. The targets were inspected in the afternoon. The targets were outlined like four four-engine bombers, and were cut out of the turf making them visible. Twelve MiG-15s were parked on the eastern edge of the field. (1)
2. On the morning of 29 August, two-seater single-engine low-wing monoplanes with radial engines flew over the field. (2) several officers had deserted from the airfield recently. new air force officers had arrived at the installation. Trucks sedan 50X1-HUM and jeep were observed near the field. 50X1-HUM
3. Two radio trucks were parked on the eastern edge of the field. Since the road to Glocksinn was no longer blocked the radio installations could be observed. The location of the radio installation with four masts was unchanged. (3) However, the radio mast with rungs previously observed about 20 meters north of the installation was recently moved to a point about 120 meters east of this installation. A perpendicular rod about 50 cm long projected beyond the top of the mast. No guy wire, insulators or wires were observed. (4) 50X1-HUM
