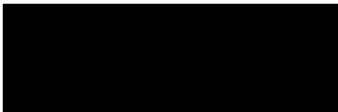

1. On 6 August 1951, a freight-train of ten cars was unloaded at the supply depot at Satzkorn near Wustermark. The receiving label was marked "Einheit Semenchenko". The train carried 1734 sacks of meal weighing a total of about 130,000 kg.

2. The cars had the following designations and numbers:

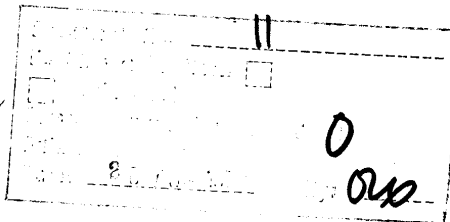
