DO NOT CIRCULATE

In mid-October 1951 the following Sino-Soviet jointly established and controlled factories were in the Hsinhsiangfang (新香坊) area, southwest of Harbin:

- a. The Hsinhsiangfang Repair Factory, which repairs damaged weapons and tanks and assembles new weapons and tanks of all types, including all heavy weapons and all large tanks sent to the Chinese Communists from the USSR. Two hundred and fifty Soviet and 100 Chinese Communist ordnance technicians, 700 Soviet and 1,000 Chinese Communist mechanics, and 2,000 Chinese Communist unskilled workers are employed at this factory.
- b. The Hsinhsiangfang Aircraft Assembling Plant, in the Hsinhsiangfang Airfield area, which repairs damaged aircraft and assembles almost all new aircraft sent to China from the USSR. The planes are flight tested in the Hsinhsiangfang area and then sent to all parts of China. Two hundred Soviet aviation technicians, mechanics, and unskilled workers are employed at this factory (sic).
