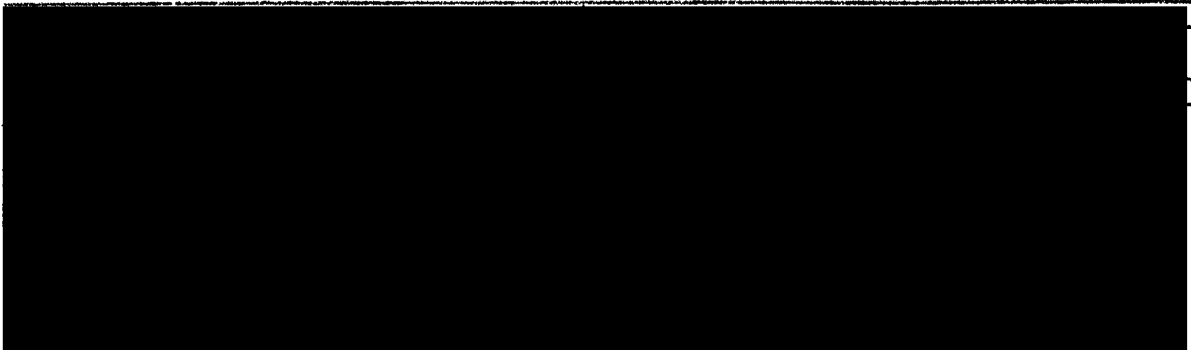

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. The Government Enterprise for the Mechanization and Investment in Agriculture has a branch in Strumica which is located one thousand meters east of Strumica on the Strumica-Novoo Selo road. The Enterprise has the following tasks:
 - a. Propaganda for the mechanization of agriculture in the Strumica district;
 - b. Supplying machinery for the collectives;
 - c. Repair of the trucks, tractors, and other machines of the collectives;
 - d. Construction of collective buildings in the Strumica district; and
 - e. Transportation of the collectives' agricultural products to Strumica, the Miravci railroad station and the collective warehouses.
2. The following were the leading personnel in the Enterprise:
 - a. Pande Nokovski, a former field guard, manager;
 - b. Cvetan, a Bulgarian refugee, personnel chief;
 - c. Dinco Batev and Ljubica Hristova, accountants;
 - d. Vasil Basmandijev, a warehouse keeper, and
 - e. A White Russian who was an engineer.
3. The Enterprise employed approximately 40 clerical workers, 30 tractor drivers, 24 craftsmen, 6 truck drivers, and a number of other workers.
4. The Enterprise had the following vehicles and machinery:
 - a. Two new 2½-ton, 40-horsepower Pionir trucks which were made in the Maribor automobile factory;
 - b. One old eight-cylinder, 3-ton Ford truck;
 - c. Twelve old 70-horsepower Oliver and Allis-Chalmers tractors;
