1. [Redacted] the following units have started to move from Kolarovgrad toward Sliven: 5 Field Artillery Regiment, 4 Division; 3 Heavy Artillery Regiment, 3 Army; and 7 Infantry Regiment, 4 Division.

2. [Redacted] 33 Infantry Regiment has moved from Nikopol to Chirpan (RA-9605). After 33 Infantry Regiment departed, an unidentified unit moved into Nikopol.

3. There was a junior officers school in Turnovo; the school was directed by Major Paskalev and had about 2,000 students. There was another junior officers school, including 300 students [Redacted] in Ruse.

4. In Stara Zagora there was a baikal unit of 1500 men, which arrived in April 1951. Members of the unit wear green hats and green uniforms.
