- On 14 October, a troop train heading toward Dessau was observed at the Berlin-Rehbruecke railroad station. The train carried trucks which had [redacted] were loaded with reels and telephone poles, and escorted by soldiers who wore black-bordered black epaulets. (2)
- Numerous troop trains, which were loaded in the Cottbus railroad subdistrict under special security provisions between 14 and 18 October included: 2 trains from Cottbus to Weisswasser on 14 October and 16 October; 6 trains from Schwepnitz and Koenigsbrueck to an unknown destination and 2 trains to Meissen on 16 October; 1 train from Schwepnitz to Oschatz during the night of 16 October and 1 train to Rueckmarsdorf on 17 October; and 1 train from Grossenhain to Frankfurt/Oder on 18 October. - The troop train on 14 October from Cottbus to Weisswasser mentioned in paragraph 3, consisted of 8 boxcars with about 120 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets, and about 48 flatcars with about 60 trucks, including [redacted]

- The troop train, which left Cottbus for Weisswasser on 16 October, included 14 boxcars with 300 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets, and materiel, probably ammunition, which had been hauled to the railroad station the day before from storerooms in the partially destroyed barracks installations south of Vetschauer Strasse. The undetermined number of flatcars of the train carried about 12 AT guns with a short barrel, 12 AA guns of a small caliber with a long barrel, 1 armored scout car, 2 armored vehicles and 59 trucks [redacted] Some of the trucks had arrived at the station via Forst-Guben highway, probably from the barracks installation in Dissenchen.

- On 17 October, 30 cars were loaded at Grossenhain airfield with large crates which exceeded the prescribed load measurements and probably contained aircraft parts. The shipment left for Frankfurt/Oder on 18 October.
- Troop trains, which were listed in the record of the Frankfurt/Oder railroad station as having gone to Brest Litovsk between 17 and 19 October included:

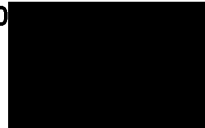

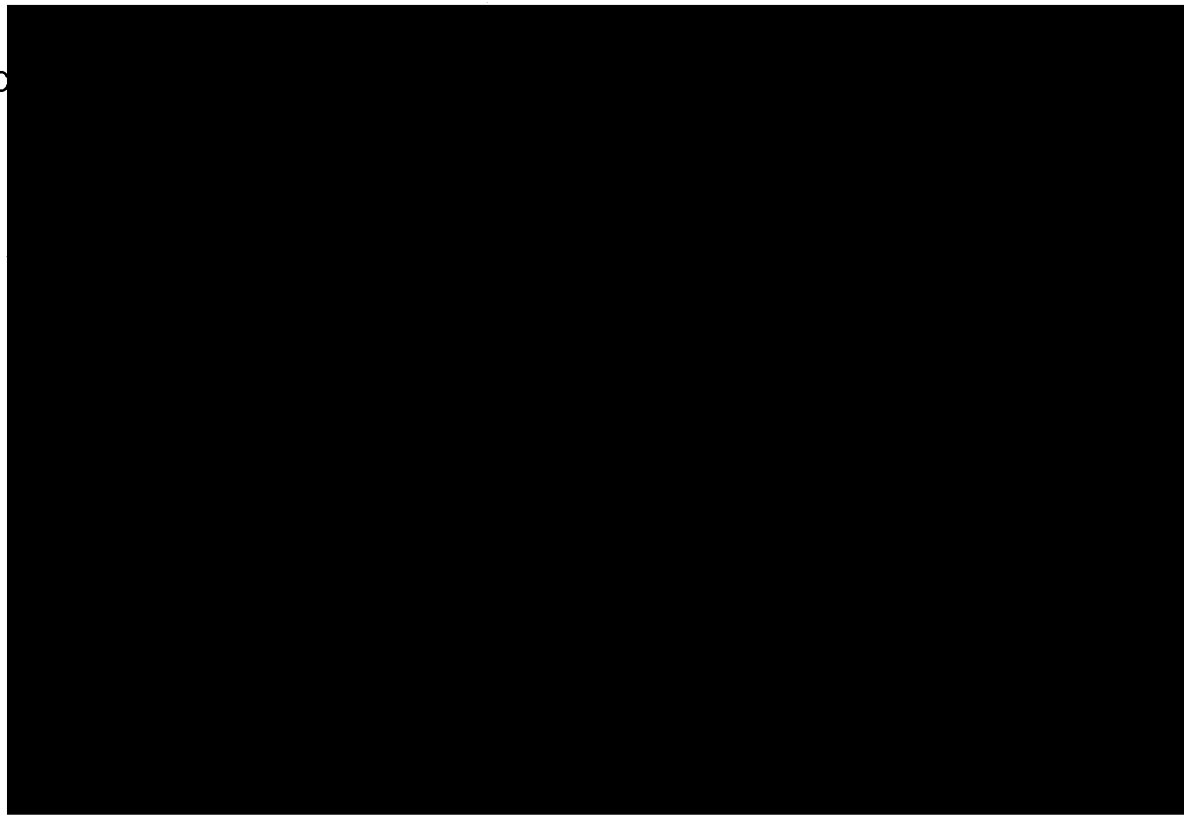
