It can therefore be concluded that components of the hitherto unlocated 1st Assault Engr Regt of the army are stationed in the barracks installation in Bresden-Webigau. Alements of the unit probably returned from engineer exercises. However, the unit was not observed at any of the engineer training sites this summer. 25X1A (3) The AA gun emplacement has not changed since the report of July 1951 from the same source. Two other sources reported only four Al guns in February and May 1951 respectively. 25X1A (4) The Waldau railroad station is located north of the Adolf Mitler Kaserne. On 18 September 1951, another source reported that the installation was only partly occupied and stated that a new tank unit would nowe in in the fall of 1951. (5) A convoy of the 36th Pon Bridge Regt of the GOFG, which is stationed in Rosslau (6) The information from the post confirms that a component of the 9th Tank Div returned to its post from the Koenigsbrueck troop training grounds. See Comment (1). (7) The trucks hauling billeting equipment to the barracks installation in Leipzig belong to the 8th Gds Decz Div and indicate that this division also returned from the troop training grounds. On 14 October, another source reported an artillery component of the division to have left Koenigsbruck. 25X1A This is the first report stating that vehicles of headquarters units of the First Cds Mecz Army and the 8th Gds Mecz Div moved into the Flak Kaserne Leipzig-Schoenau, to date, only components of the Eighth Gds Army have been carried there. (8) The information indicates that engineer training in the Gross Kuehnau area was still in progress in mid-October. Ten of the vehicles mentioned belong to: the XXVIII Gds Mtz Rifle Corps, including the corps headquarters; the SEOth May Bn; the SEOth Engr Bn of the 20th Sds Mecs Div; and the 39th Gds Mis Mille Miv. One of the vehicles belongs to headquarters units of the LEMIX Mtz Mafile Corps, I to the air force and I to the With Gds Mecz Regt of the Lith Gds Mecz Dival
