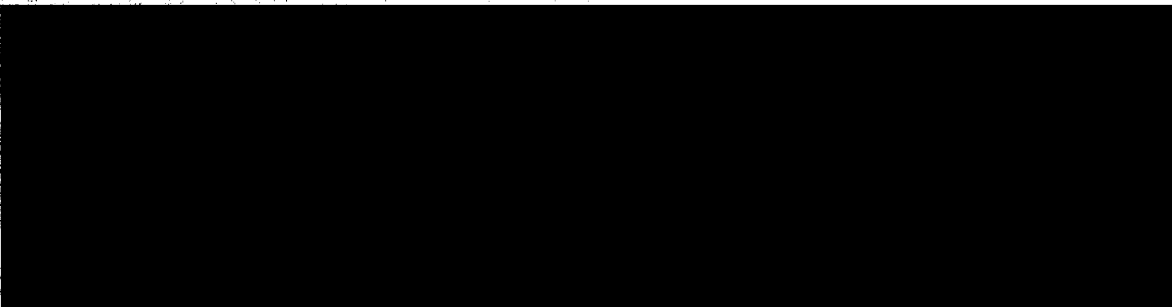

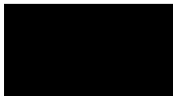
1. The Communist printing establishment in Chile, "Imprenta Pacifico", which recently changed its name to "Talleres Graficos Lautaro", under court order*, is [redacted] to be undergoing renovation. A new, improved press is being installed to facilitate the publication of the Chilean Communist newspaper Democracia, which became a daily newspaper in November 1951.
2. The Communist drive recently undertaken for funds to operate Democracia** is considered successful by Communist leaders, who calculate that by December 1951 the publication will have a reserve fund of approximately one million pesos (\$10,000 U.S.). The editorial staff of Democracia has been augmented as well and is now composed of the following:
