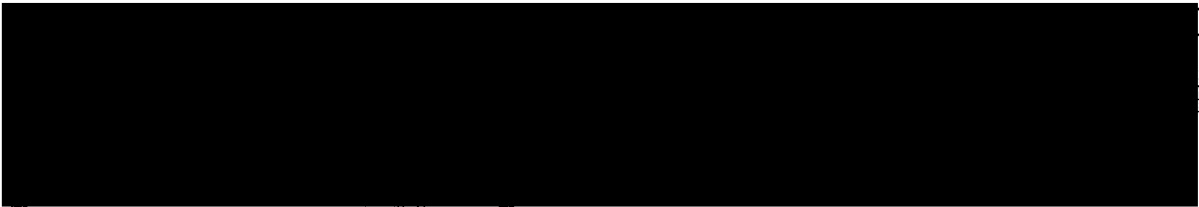

Greek Prime Minister Plastiras is reported to have said to his inner political circle that he will remove Lieutenant General Thrasylvoulos Tsakalotos as Chief of the Greek General Staff because he is incompetent and is "a Venizelos man." Plastiras allegedly added that Tsakalotos will be replaced either by Lieutenant General Stylianos Manidakis, Commander of 'C' Corps in Salonika, or by Lieutenant General Thrasylvoulos Zaimis, Commander of 'B' Corps.¹
