- 1. On 10 September 1951 CH'EN Te-ch'eng (陳德誠), leader of a guerrilla force on Wuch'iu Island (119-27, 25-00), and six men were surrounded by militia forces at Ch'ient'ou (119-10, 25-13). The militiamen were aided by a company of Chinese Communist troops stationed at P'ut'ang (項 境).
 All six guerrillas, including the leader, were killed. The leader was beheaded and his head was displayed for several days at Tungkut'ung (東 道 海). A second leader, CH'EN Ch'ing (於 情), was captured by the Chinese Communists on 14 September 1951 at Ch'uanchou (118-34, 24-54). A third leader, LIU Sunch'uan (何 依 於), was killed when surrounded by Communists in the vicinity of Fengwei (118-54, 25-07).
- In early October 1951 six guerrillas led by CHEN Pi-ch'eng (就 數 成) arrived in the Laichu (藏 庭) area to seek boat transportation. The men were encircled and attacked by a company of Chinese Communist troops, who killed five of the guerrillas and captured the other.
