3. Forty field kitchens arrived at Frankfurt/Oder-Winterhafen (harbor) on 4 October from an undetermined location. Thirty field kitchens were loaded for an undetermined destination on 12 October. ***

* **Comment:** A Russian term for an inferior type of tobacco.

*** **Comment:** The information confirms the 820th Main Supply Depot, of the GDFG in Frankfurt/Oder. Detailed information on the depot was contained in a previous report. For the first time the number of outgoing shipments exceeded that of incoming shipments. Specifically, 213 carloads of supply, including 121 carloads of flour, were dispatched and 144 carloads, including 52 carloads of flour, arrived. The flour stock-piling program was continued. It is undetermined whether the fact that outpoint shipments exceeded incoming shipments is connected with the decentralization of depots and stocks as was observed with ammunition and fuel depots.

**** **Comment:** The depot for field kitchen accessories and mess utensils in Frankfurt/Oder-Winterhafen (harbor) is known. It has the numerical designation 3289 and, probably, It seems that it is subordinate to the 820th Supply Depot of the GDFG. The incoming shipment has not been listed in reports on rail movements. The outgoing shipment was listed in a previously report.
