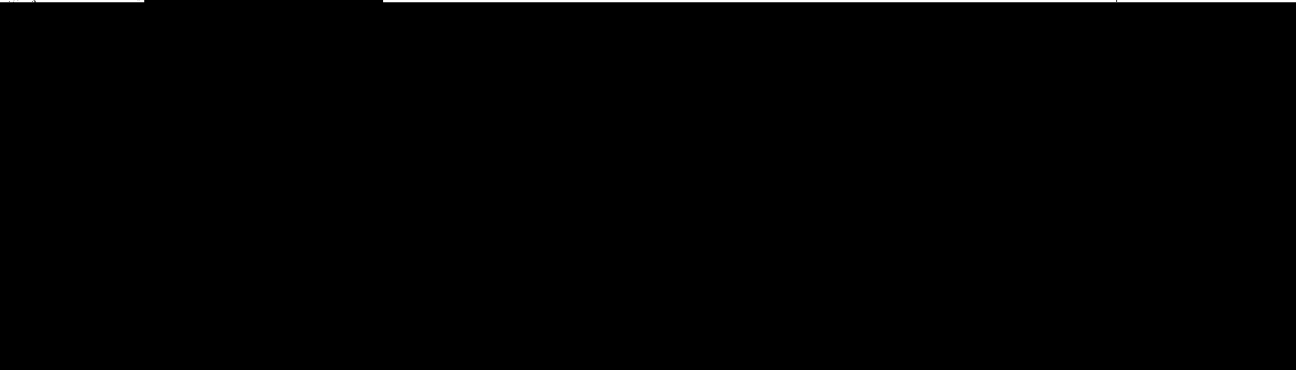

1. The building to house the power plant for the Dosnica hydroelectric plant was completed in August 1951. The building is located about three kilometers north of the village of Dren near Demir Kapija.
2. A dam has been constructed about 16 kilometers south of Dren which will form an artificial lake from the water of the Dosnica River. A line of cement pipes 16 kilometers long was laid underground from the dam to the power plant building to carry the water from the lake. In the construction of the pipeline, ten tunnels will be necessary through the hilly areas; of these, seven have been completed and work has begun on the other three. All of the construction work is scheduled to be completed on the power plant by the end of 1951.
3. The plans call for the installation of three turbines in the hydroelectric plant, but at the end of August 1951 none of them had arrived.
4. The construction of the plant is being carried out by the Svetlost Government Building Enterprise which has its headquarters in Skoplje. The Enterprise has about 30 office employees and 600 laborers working on the plant.

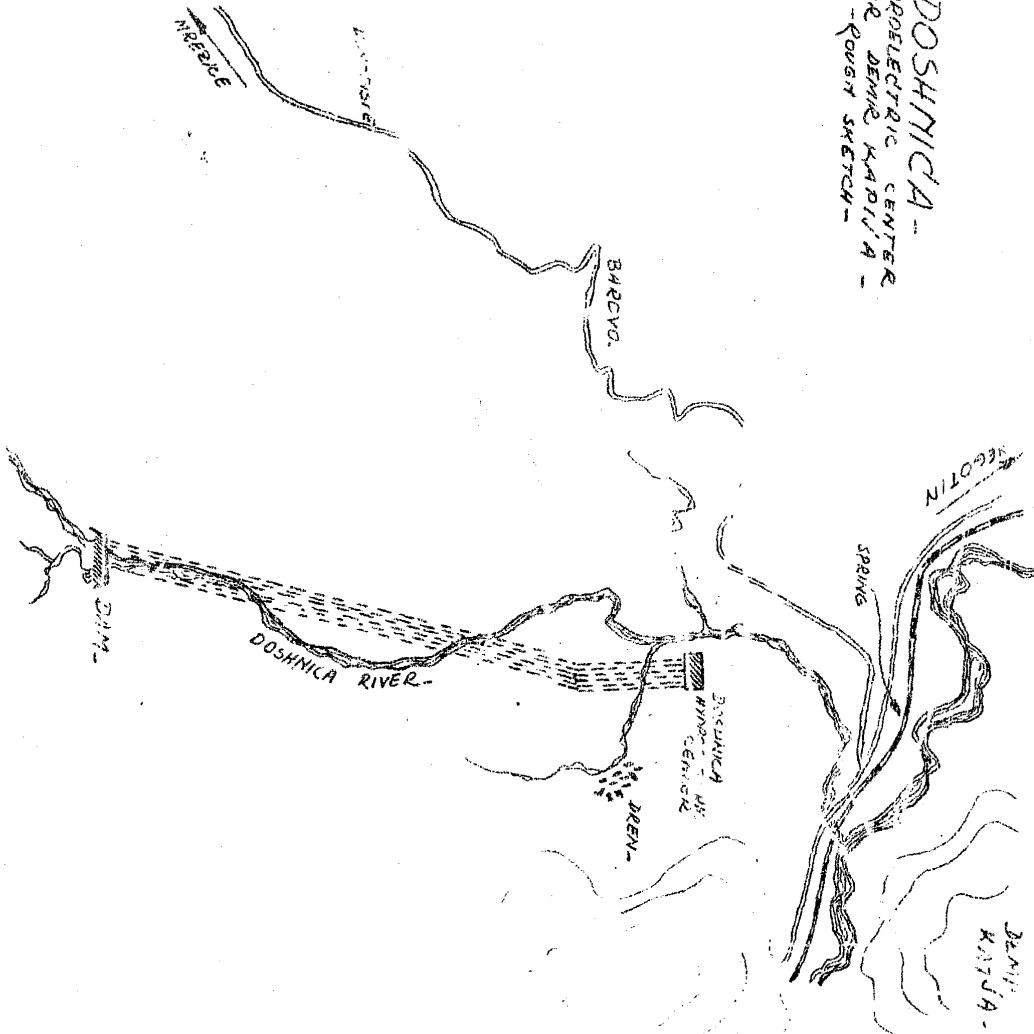
