- 5. Troop Rations. In addition to rice and other food, each soldier received a small daily allowance for tobacco and other expenses. Officers of the front receive the same allowances and live in the same manner as the troops.
- 6. Propaganda. Radio propaganda of the front is supplemented by a weekly bulletin entitled Duoc Giai Phong (Torch of Liberation).
