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The following information was received on airfields in Hungary:

| Airfield | Date of Observation | Observation and Evaluation |

| Papa (P 48/Y 30) | | Occupation: 16 to 18 silver-colored jet planes with considerably high rudder assemblies and covered with tarpaulins except for four planes; 20 to 25 single-engine planes; 18 to 20 twin-engine planes near the three hangars. There was no flying. From 120 to 150 Soviet soldiers were observed near the aircraft |
| Kalocsa (Y 6/N 31) | | On 1 August 1951, construction started on an airfield west of Kalocsa, just north of the road to Foktoe (Y 5/N 21). grading work on the field which is in the vicinity of the new barracks buildings. No construction started on the buildings at the field. ** |
