From a small vessel in the Bay of Luebeck in the summer of 1951, two small patrol vessels were seen which, in good weather, would patrol the waters (54°00'N/11°27'E) 3 to 5 nautical miles off Poel Island. They would alter course to the opposite direction at a point 5 or 6 nautical miles west of the Gedser Riff Lightvessel (54°29'N/12°10'E). They would proceed at about 5 knots, and sometimes even remained stationary for several hours. No such vessels were observed with wind force No 4. *Fishermen in Wismar (53°54'N/11°29'E) stated that these vessels were to prevent smuggling of persons.
