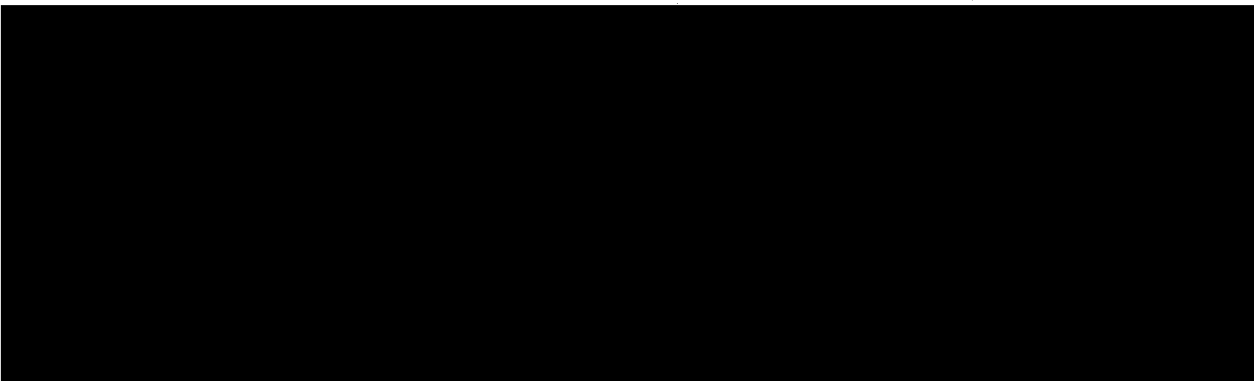

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO 25X1X



1. During September and October, anti-Communist guerrillas in the Laoshan area made several raids on Ssuifang (四方) and Tsangk'ou (沧口), Tsingtao. The guerrillas have purchased arms and ammunition from Communist military cadres for shipment to their areas. When the collusion was discovered, many local businessmen were involved and LIU Yu-chi (劉玉奇), a staff officer of the Tsingtao Garrison Command, disappeared. WANG Chih-ming (王志明), manager of the Ta Kung (大公) Trading Company on Luifang (萊陽) Road, was arrested for being the intermediary.
2. On 7 November anti-Communist elements placed a bomb in the engine room of a Chinese Communist vessel in the 1 Naval Dock, Tsingtao. The bomb exploded during the night. Over thirty persons have been arrested for questioning.
