- 1. During September and October, anti-Communist guerrillas in the Laoshan area wash several raids on Soulang (〒方) and Tsangktou (美 皮), Tsingtao, The guerrillas have purchased arms and ammunition from Communist military cadres for shimment to their areas. When the collusion was discovered many local tusinessmen were involved and LIU Yu-chi (紀 氏 奇), a staff officer of the Tsingtao Garrison Command, disappeared, WANG Chih-ming (王 松 明), scanager of the Ta Kung (大石) Trading Company on Laiyang (葉 鴉) Road, was arrested for being the intermediary.
- On 7 Mc vember anti-Communist elements placed a bomb in the engine room of a Chinese Communist vessel in the 1 Naval Dock, Tsingtoo. The boxb exploded during the night. Over thirty persons have been arrested for questioning.
