1. The following numbers of Soviet troops were observed aboard leave trains in Frankfurt/Oder on 29 and 30 November:

Date	To Brest Litovsk	From Brest Litovsk
29 November	300 and 290	420 and 380
30 November	320 and 280	370 and 450

2. Troop trains listed in the records of the 4th Subdistrict Office of the Berlin railroad district included: a train of 31 boxcars and 14 flatcars, [Redacted], from Jueterbog to Werneuchen on 1 December; a train of 18 boxcars and 22 flatcars, [Redacted] from Jueterbog to Werneuchen on 2 December; and a train of 21 boxcars and 29 flatcars, [Redacted] from Oranienburg to Jueterbog on 2 December.

3. The following trains carrying troops were listed in the records of the 7th Subdistrict Office of the Berlin railroad district between 1 and 5 December:




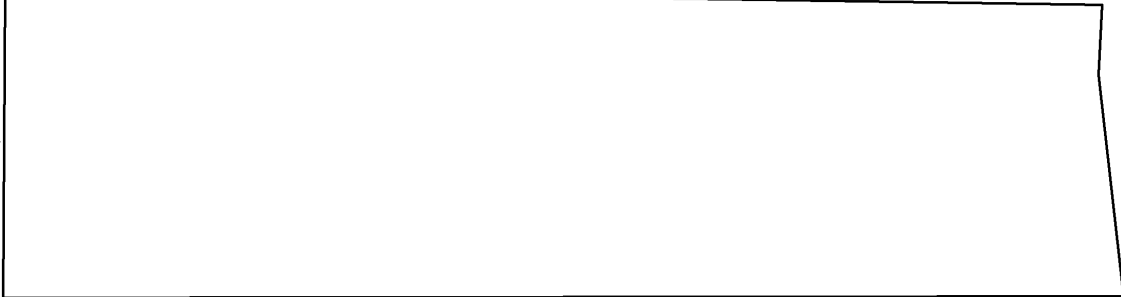
