- 1. Location:** The power plant in Br [redacted] Russian SSR, is south of the west rail [redacted] west of the street which crosses the main Wa [redacted] continues toward the north to the town of Brest. The plant is 300 meters [redacted] the Mukhavets River.
- 2. Plant installations:** The plant covers an area of about 400 x 150 meters. The plant building, a block about 80 x 50 meters, was destroyed during the war. It was rebuilt and put into operation in 1948. The plant building is divided into three sections. The turbine hall has two turbines. For plant layout, see Annex 1. Two railroad tracks, one of Soviet, one of normal gauge, enter the plant at the west.
- 3. Work force:** For reconstruction of the plant: 200 workers. For plant operation: about 25 workers per shift, 50 percent women.
- 4. Capacity:** One turbine 1,500 KW and the other 3,600 KW. The plant supplied the power for the village of Kobrin and other villages in the immediate vicinity of the plant. [redacted]

5. **Location:** The power [redacted] on the southwestern border of the town between the Muk [redacted] the railroad line to Warsaw.

6. **Plant installations:** [redacted] the plant, [redacted] during the war, was started in 1945. According to fellow [redacted] For earlier, the plant started operation with two turb [redacted] plant layout, see Annex 2.

- 1 Garage, wooden structure, 125 x 10 x 5 meters
- 2 Main building, 120 x 40 x 25 meters, iron structure with masonry, two turbines, two boilers and two sheet-metal smokestacks
- 3 Repair shop and magazine, 50 x 8 x 4 meters, brick structure
- 4 Administration building, 15 x 12 meters, under construction
- 5 Guard house and entrance
- 6 Coal storage
- 7 Small pool
- 8 Wooden bridge crossing the Mukhavets River
- 9 Park area.

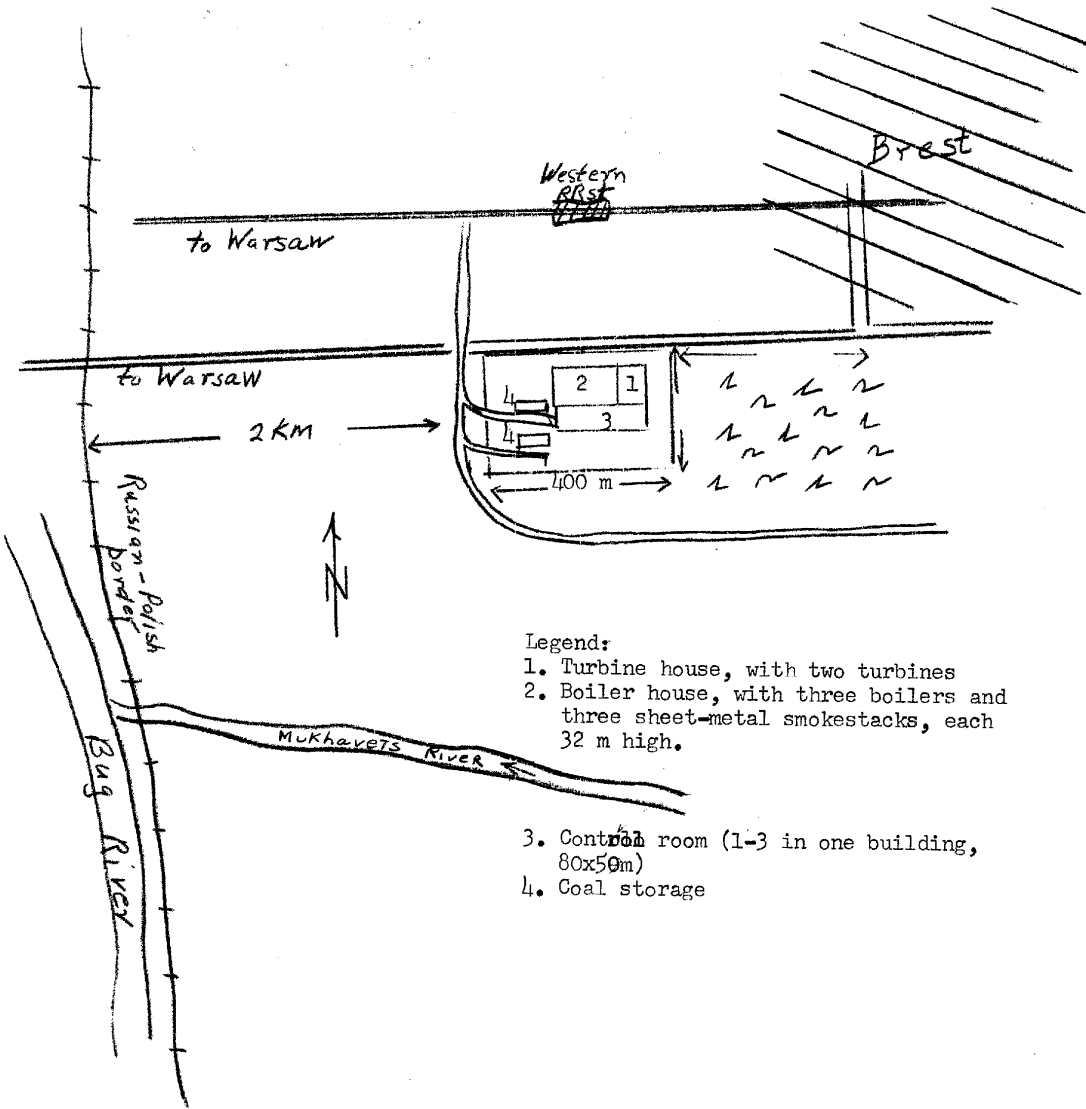

- 4. Coal storage

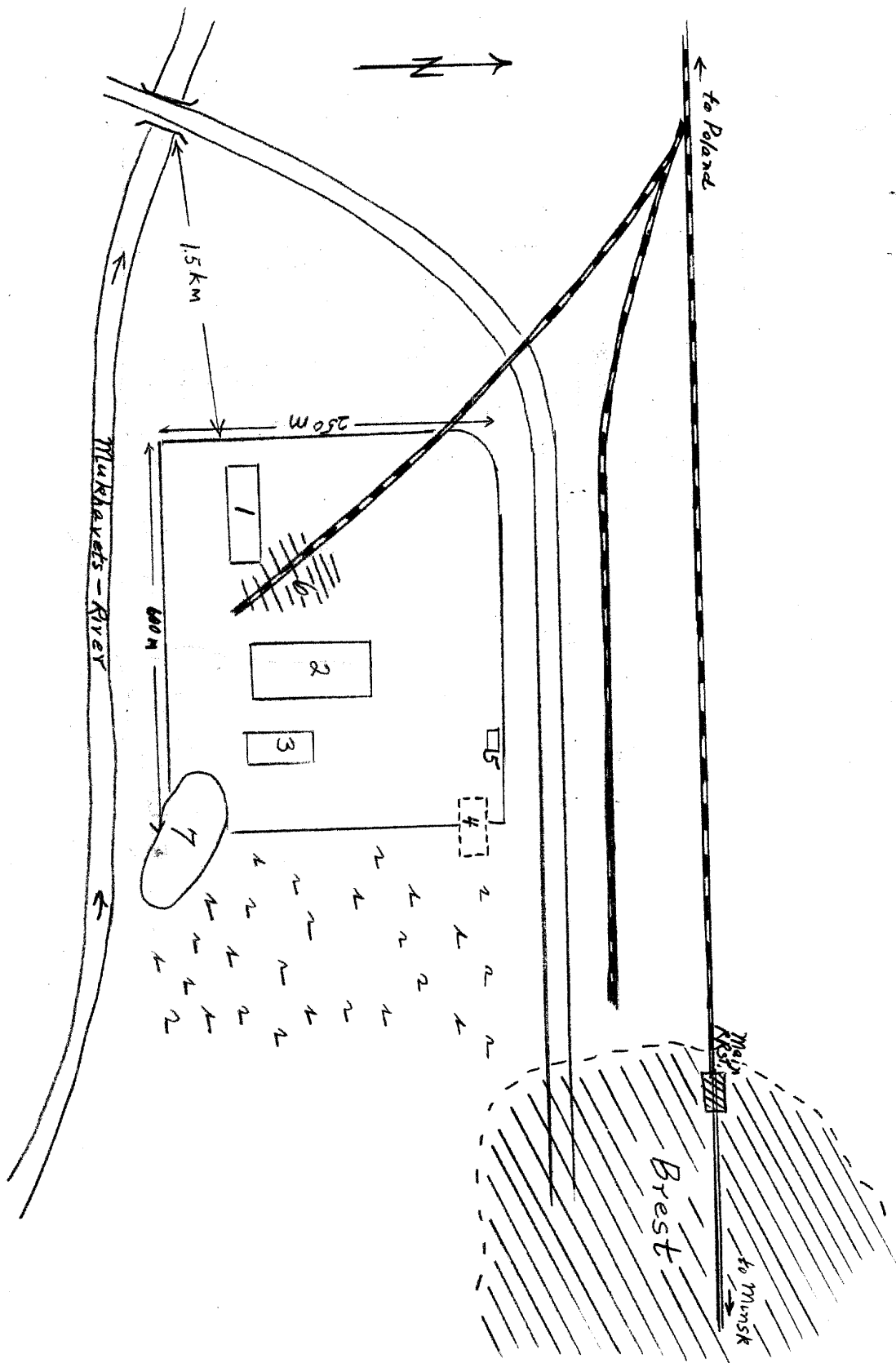
