25X1 1. At 3:30 p.m. on 5 December 1951, six MIG-15s were observed at Neubrandenburg-Trollen-
hagen airfield. A radio truck was parked near the runway. [redacted] 25X1B
25X1B [redacted] transported soldiers who
25X1B were going on leave to the railroad station; they also transported workers to the
field. Ambulance [redacted] was also observed at the field.

2. At noon on 14 December, 14 MIG-15s, 3 single-engine planes, and a radio truck with
a rod antenna were observed at the field. The jet planes took off individually or
