There was intensive flying in good weather. A radic truck with a mast 6 meters high was observed in the middle of the landing field. A similar radio installation was about 75 meters north of the DF station with four masts. * (coment. According to another source, the MiG-15s which arrived at Merseburg airfield bilong to one of the two fighter regiments which have been newly organized 25X1A aircraft previously belonged to a fighter regiment in Alt Lornovitz, the flying personnel of which were transferred to the U.S.S.R. in mid-October 1951. The other have not previously belonged to the U.S.S.R. in in Mostren since November 1951. According to repeatedly confirmed reports, the 25X1 have not previously been observed in 25X1 the Soviet Zone of Germany.
