- 4. Purchases of diamonds by the firm are not recorded in the Receiving (Wareneingang) Department. The setting of diamonds into cylindrical plates is done by the Maus firm in Berlin-Adlershof.\*\*
- 5. Resin for impregnating cables is imported illegally from United States firms via Rostock. The resin is shipped in zinc containers on which the sending firm's inscription has been made illegible.
- Lead is obtained from Czechoslovakia and illegally from Western firms via Rostock.
