1. The following shipments arrived at Wulkow between 1 December 1951 and 1 January 1952, consigned to [redacted] and dispatched by [redacted] 25X1

No outgoing shipments were observed during the time covered by the report. \*

2. Residents, familiar with the situation at the installation, stated that only artillery and tank ammunition and no infantry ammunition was stored at the depot. A Soviet lieutenant of the escorting detail of the shipment on 22 December said that the shipment consisted of artillery ammunition, mortar shells and AAA ammunition. The depot was allegedly filled to capacity. The installations necessary for the production of ammunition had been torn down by the Soviets in 1945 and 1946 and have not been rebuilt. \*\*

Comment. The information confirms the Soviet ammunition depot at Wulkow until the beginning of January 1952. The incoming shipments were listed in reports on rail movements. [redacted] a dispatching office at Frankfurt/Oder. [redacted] the ammunition depot, Wulkow. As the report appears credible, the information that no ammunition was dispatched by rail from Wulkow during December 1951 is considered correct. The increase of incoming shipments of ammunition from the U.S.S.R., as was generally observed, is believed to be in order to fill up the depots.

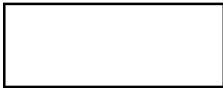



25X1 at Bulkow was believed to store exclusively artillery ammunition. The  
present report, however, indicates that not only artillery, but also  
tank and AAA ammunition is being stock-piled there and that, apparently,  
no light infantry ammunition is stored at the depot. This information  
is considered possible.
