The only military quarters observed in Apolda (M 52/J 67) during the period from 7 to 9 January 1952 was a three-story building near the railroad station which was occupied by about 50 soldiers who wore red-bordered black epaulets. Local residents said that these troops were detached from a unit in Weimar.

A lieutenant but no sentry was observed in front of the building. Truck [redacted] was also seen in front of the building.
