A guerrilla-type resistance group of 500 men, which clashed with Government troops in the Sliven section of the Stara Planina, successfully blew up a freight train near Sliven. The train was loaded with ammunition which allegedly originated in the USSR, and was being shipped from Burgas to Sofia.
