- 1. The Polish Armed Forces are presently equipped with two types of T-34 medium tanks, the T-34/76 and the T-34/85. The tanks are being modified constantly, particularly as regards the 12-cylinder V-2-34 engine.
- 2. The T-34/85 tank is equipped with one 85 mm artillery piece and two 7.62 mm machine guns marked "DT". The tank carries 2,762 rounds for the two machine guns, 300 rounds of pistol ammunition, 25 hand grenades, 20 signal projectiles, and 55 rounds for the artillery. Specifications of the tank are as follows:
