25X1 Between 22 and 27 January 1952, jet bombers may have been located at Cottbus airfield. On several days, two jet bombers were observed over Cottbus. Trucks came from the direction of the field. *

25X1 * Comment. [Redacted] 25X1
[Redacted] two jet bombers landed at the field on 16 January 1952. Fuel shipments from the Riesa depot, which supplies fuel to jet bomber bases, and the appearance of jet bombers over Cottbus may indicate that the bomber regiment previously equipped with Pe-2s will be reequipped with jet bombers.
