FANG Fang, secretary of the South China Sub-Bureau of the Chinese Communist Party, arrived in Macao on 6 January 1952. On 7 January he called a meeting of Communist officials on the second floor of the Nan Kuang Trading Company and asked them to complete their preparatory work for the "liberation" of Macao. Chinese Communist authorities have appointed FANG Fang to be the first mayor of Macao after they take Macao and have decided to give the name of Hao Chiang Shih (濠江市) to Macao and attach it directly to Kwangtung Province. On 9 January FANG Fang returned to Canton via Shihch'i on the Ch'i Kuan (岐關) highway in a black sedan bearing [Redacted]
