THIS IS UNEVALUATED INFORMATION

1. At the HF-Werk, in Berlin-Oberschoeneweide, Ostendstrasse 1-5, the daily quota of radio grids is 34,000 pieces. The number corresponds to a quantity of 15-20,000 tubes per day.
2. The production plan for the important "T-2" program is 1952 calls for 60,000 tube sets, with 31 tubes per set. In 1951 it was 42,000 sets, with 20 tubes per set. This represents an increase from 840,000 tubes in 1951 to 1,860,000 in 1952.
3. The total tube production, outside the "T-2" program, was 1,200,000 in 1951. For 1952, 2,400,000 pieces are planned.
4. Mica is obtained from the West through interzone exchange, as the purchasing department of the works has announced. However, the quantity delivered by the West is so limited that it meets only a small part of the requirements.
5. A new teletype apparatus has been developed in the HF-Werk. It is intended for the postal service. Preparations are being made to manufacture it by mass production.
