THIS IS UNEVALUATED INFORMATION

1. Both the Wavelberg Engineering School in Warsaw and the Warsaw Polytechnic School presently give reserve officers training courses for the Polish Army. At both schools, courses in all branches of the army are given, but Wavelberg specializes in training for the tank corps, while Warsaw Polytechnic specializes in intensive artillery courses.
2. Training is conducted utilizing the same equipment now issued to the Polish Army. The tank course at Wavelberg uses light, medium and heavy tanks, specifically the T-70-45 light, T-34-76 and T-34-85 mediums, and the Josef Stalin heavy tanks. All students taking part in these courses participate in the regular summer maneuvers of the Polish Army and are attached to army units of their specialty for the maneuver period.
