1. The manufacture of curve potentiometers was resumed about a month ago. They have individual 24 volt motor drives. The eccentric recording diameter is about 400 mm. They are designated by the numbers 0815-14. The Volkseigener Betrieb (VEB) Kaloriferwerk Dessau and VEB Medizin Leipzig are the consignees. The potentiometers have a resistance of about 125 ohms. Material has been supplied for an estimated 4,000-5,000 pieces.
2. The so-called infra-sighting apparatus is also manufactured. Only skilled men returned from the Soviet Union work here. Apparently the design also is from the Soviet Union. The apparatus is equipped with a telescopic Zeiss Ikon camera. Ten to fifteen pieces of apparatus are dispatched monthly.
3. The manufacture of ships' optical equipment has apparently been much increased in recent months. Shipments have gone to Rostock and Wismar within the last three weeks.
4. Field glasses, sighting telescopes and periscopes are manufactured in large quantities after old German army models. Improvements have been made in the optics. Shipments go by ship to the Soviet Union, Poland, and the other people's democracies. The manufacture of microscopes is stopped for the present. The moving picture and mechanical departments are to be enlarged.
