THIS IS UNEVALUATED INFORMATION

1. On 19 March 1952 the Chinese Communist Government ordered an end to the Five Anti's Campaign because trade within China is at a standstill. All cases which are before local courts on Five Anti's charges are to be decided, and those cases involving embezzlement of less than 10 million JMP are to be delayed.

2. In late March 1952 the Kwangtung Sixth Military Sub-district Command sent 600 convicted landlords from Chungshan to Neilington (113- , 22- ), Tungao (113- , 22- ), and the Wanshan Islands to work on the construction of fortifications.
