25X1 * [redacted] Comment. For the first time since November 1951, incoming and outgoing food shipments assumed major proportions at the 820th Ration Supply Depot of the SOFG in Frankfurt/Oder. Except for tobacco products, a total of 256 carloads arrived and 191 carloads left the installation. The arrival of 73 carloads of flour and the shipping out of 46 carloads of flour are noteworthy. This increased turnover may be connected with the Soviet Zone grain shuttle program which was started in mid-January 1952. [redacted]

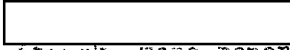
