

The following orders have been received by Zeiss-Jena for delivery of goods to Russian [] in Germany:

1. [] (actual receiving []). The order is dated [] and signed Baranov. It calls for the delivery of one optical dividing head with transformer 220/6 volts, 2.2 watts. The price is 4,554.DM. The item is to be delivered to an address to be stated later. 25X1B

2. [] delivery point Fuerstenwalde/Spree, at the spur line to airport, RBD Berlin. The order calls for 15 monocular microscopes LgoB, 56-1330 power. The cost of each item is 795.20 DM. The order is dated [] and is signed by Baranov [] 25X1B

3. [] delivery point Fuerstenwalde/Spree, RBD Berlin. The order is signed by Baranov, [] and calls for one loud-speaker, 9 watts with amplifier, price 4,050.DM. 25X1A

4. Order from Lieutenant Colonel Yegorov [] for a fifteen-power ocular (Kompens-Okular). Zeiss serves notice that it will not hold the instrument beyond [] The order has been ready for delivery since 24 October [] but Yegorov has failed to call for it. 25X1B

5. In early February [] a detail of four Russian soldiers came to Zeiss-Jena and presented a request that Zeiss repair a lathe for their unit, [] in Loebstedt, on the outskirts of Jena.

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
