The sectors of the PS battaliens in Hranice and As have not been determined. They apparently face Bavarian territory as well as the territory of the Seviet Zone of Germany.

5. The structure of the PS brigade and battalion headquarters has not been determined. Officer posts at brigade and battalion headquarters include those of commanding officer, adjutant, chief of staff, political officer, DOZ officer, indoctrination officer, youth activities officer, supply officer, motor transport officer, administrative officer, cipher officer and medical officer. Only brigade headquarters has an additional engineer officer and personnel officer; and only battalion headquarters has an additional ordnance officer. Senior ECOs sometimes fill officer posts at the battalion level.

Personnel and Strength .

- 7. Since the fall of 1950, the PS units have been receiving draftees out of the normal classes of recruits. Draftees of the 1929 and 1930 classes were inducted into the PS training units in July 1951 and distributed to the PS companies in the fall of 1951. Personnel from PS units are discharged only in the fall of each year, and it is fairly definitely believed that the term of service with the PS units amounts to 2 years and 3 months.
- 8. Since the fall of 1951, the strengths of PS companies have been raised from about 40 men to an average of 50 or 60 men, so that each PS battalion has an average strength of 425 men. The strength of a PS brigade headquarters, including its headquarters units and the training battalion, is estimated at 500 to 700. The five brigades committed to border guard duty along the Bavarian border are therefore believed to have a total strength of 11,000 to 12,000.
- 9. During the initial period of their existence, the PS units included Slovaks, sometimes as many as hO percent of their total strength. The number of Slovaks was gradually reduced to about 10 percent of the command, probably because of the numerous desertions by members of this ethnic group. It is believed that the program under which Slovaks were replaced by Czechs has been virtually

completed.

10. It is conspicuous that the PG units are commanded and staffed by officers whose rank is out of proportion to the posts they fill. For example, brigades are commanded by captains and battalions and companies by lieutenants. A number of brigade commanders were detached to the U.S.S.R. to attend training courses in the fall of 1951.

Weapons, Equipment and Uniforms.

- 11. The PS units are armed with Czech rifles and former Cerman model 98 rifles, model 48-A and model 48-B submachine guns and pistols. An average company has in addition 3 to 6 light machine guns of model 26 and I heavy machine gun of model 37. There may be 62-mm mortars with the brigade headquarters units. Cld German gas masks have been occasionally observed with PS units.
- 12. The PS units are not fully motorized, but have only as many motor vehicles as are required to maintain logistical support and to make components of the units truck-borne in case of emergency. Each PC company has I sedan and I motorcycle; a battalion headquarters usually has h trucks, h sedans and several motorcycles; a brigade headquarters usually has about 15 trucks, 10 sedans and 10 motorcycles.

lh. All PS personnel wear a standard uniform. They have dress uniforms with redbordered green enaulets and a dog's head emblem on the lapels. The service uniforms display only the dog's head emblem on the lapels.

Border Control.

- 15. The individual PS companies guard a border stretch of about 3 km on an average, which is controlled by either patrols or, more frequently, by stationary posts of 2 or 3 men. Each company also has several trained dogs.
- 16. A string of field fortifications is being established along the entire border. Reports from numerous PS battalion sectors mentioned a barren strip raked so that the footprints of illegal border crossers are revealed, AT obstacles, mine fields, wire entanglements, and field positions which sometimes include underground shelters.
- 17. The border zone which extended to a depth of 6 to 8 km prior to 1 November 1951 has been divided into an off limits zone parallel to the border having a width of 200 to 500 meters and a subsequent border zone extending within Czechoslovakia for 5 or 6 km. All personnel other than PS personnel who entered the off limits zone had to be escorted by a member of the PS company in charge. SNO stations were located behind the border zone only:
- 18. It has been reported that there are plans providing for mutual employment of PS units and army units stationed near the border in case of major border incidents. The army units concerned can be alerted by PS authorities. In case of war, the PS units have the mission of defending the border until the armival of regular army units.

19. PS brigades are also believed to be stationed on all Czechoslovakian borders. For example, two PS brigades have been identified in Karlovy Vary and C. Budejovice respectively. But it is believed that PS units along those borders are more thinly spread than on the border facing Bavaria.
