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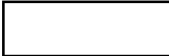
Comment. The empty flatcars will mainly be used for the shipment of tanks, motor vehicles and crated aircraft from the U.S.S.R. to the Soviet Zone of Germany. 86 refrigerator cars loaded with butter

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entered the Soviet Zone of Germany during the period from 2 through 23 February 1952. The boxcars will be used for the shipment of grain.

25X1 ** [redacted] Comment. The grain import program of the Soviet Zone of Germany has been under way since mid-January 1952. According to [redacted] the Ministry of Traffic, a total of 65,000 tons of grain were scheduled to be imported from the U.S.S.R. during the period from 1 to 29 February 1952. According to [redacted] the Directorate General, Railroads, Berlin, a total of 4,750 carloads of grain arrived in the Soviet Zone of Germany during the month of February. On the assumption that each railroad car carried an average load of 15 tons, total grain imports in February amounted to 28,255 tons. [redacted]

25X1 [redacted] the grain imports fell short of the fixed quota by 36,745 tons.

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
