- military airfields and two air force academies in the area are under the complete control of the Soviet Air Force.
- 2. One of these air training centers instructs only Chinese Communist Air Force personnel, and approximately 500 cadets recruited from China arrive there each month. In early April more than 6,000 air students were being trained at Chiamus su. 1
- The second air training center trains students for the International Liberation Air Force. 25X1

the Chinese Communists established the first paratroop training school at Chiamussu in 1949 with CHU Te as honorary commandant. In the fall of 1950 the first paratroop class of the Chiamussu paratroop school was graduated and organized into three divisions and one independent North Korean regiment. By November 1951 the school had graduated 20,000 men, all chosen from the 4 Field Army. The paratroopers were being trained by Soviet instructors, and 14,000 paratroopers were in training in November 1951.

Comment. The exact type of training air students receive is not reported.
