- 25X1 1. Arrivals of materiel directly from the Soviet Union have been observed frequently in the last few days at Priemerwald. During the night of 6 April, a train of 13 cars left Priemerwald in the direction of Berlin with seven Stalin III tanks and six anti-tank guns.

- 25X1 2. New Soviet troop units, mainly tank and infantry troops, are occupying the quarters in Fuerstenberg. On 7 April 1952, 58 tanks were counted on the training grounds near the Berlin-Neustrelitz road. The soldiers are all about 20-22 years old.
- 3. Fourteen freight cars loaded with Soviet troops have arrived at the Guestrow railway station. They appear to belong to a rocket launching unit. Ten rocket launchers with crews were observed in closed cars. The guns were covered, but were easily recognized.
