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Comment. Exclusive of tobacco products, 223 railroad cars, including 11 carloads of flour, were unloaded at, and 160 carloads, including 11 carloads of flour, shipped from the ration supply depot. An increased number of carloads of flour continued to arrive during the reported period. The flour was certainly imported from the U.S.S.R. in the new shuttle train program. Most of the outgoing shipments were dispatched to army ration supply depots.

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
