Γ	Comment. The stocks of railroad tank cars and carboy-type cars
_	suitable for the shipment of black products are reported for the first
	time. a total of 12.300 tank cars used 25X
	for the shipment of white and black products was available in the Soviet
	Zone on 1 August 1951. There is a total of 12.620 cars reported in para-
	graphs 1 and 2 of the present report as available on 1 April 1952. The
	difference between this figure and the number mentioned in reference is as
	slight that the reported figure of 10.107 tank cars used for the shipment
	of black products appears credible. Black products include acids, power
	ges, fluid chlorine, lyes, lubricants, tar, wine, molesses, alcohol, atc.
	The tank cars used for the shipment of these products are carried in the
	category of "Tank Cars and Carboy-Type Cars for Black Products" and in-
	clude cars of the most diversified types. In order to avoid time-consuming
	chemical cleaning, railroad tank cars are generally used for the trans-
	portation of a special type and hired out to producer firms. The employed
	ment of these cars is controlled by the Central Railroad Tank Car Distri-
	bution Point, Berlin.
