1. On 22 April, the Panzer Kaserne on Berliner Chaussee in Bad Freienwalde (N 53/V 28) was still occupied by about 150 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets. [REDACTED] most of the troops previously stationed there had moved to troop training grounds, allegedly in the area of Schorfheide. One T-34/85 tank [REDACTED] stood on a flatcar at the loading ramp of Bad Freienwalde railroad station on 21 April. A lieutenant with tank insignia was seen nearby. [REDACTED] artillery pieces and tanks including heavy tanks, and billeting equipment had been shipped day and night toward Schorfheide for about three weeks. [REDACTED]

of the elements of the 6th Gds Mecz Div stationed in Bad Freienwalde moved to the Templin troop training grounds north of Schorfheide between 15 and 18 April. [REDACTED] Advance details may have been transferred earlier. [REDACTED] belonged to the 1st Bn of the 68th Mecz Brig of the VIII Mecz Corps. It is rather probable that after the war the corps was renamed the 8th Mecz Div; however, for the following reasons it cannot definitely be stated that the division is now stationed in Kursk.
