the objections to Ana Pauker were chiefly:

- a. In dealing with the Rumanian National Bank and Finance Ministry, Pauker failed to implement certain Party suggestions concerning the currency reform.
- b. Pauker lacked Party discipline and failed to dismiss certain unnamed foreign service officials whose work was unsatisfactory to the Central Committee.

2. [ ] Pauker, as an important member of the Cominform, will be allowed to defend herself and may eventually, if cleared, emerge in a new capacity elsewhere.
3. [ ] expects no change in Rumanian foreign or economic policy since Pauker is still the Foreign Minister.
4. [ ] Ana Pauker's fall from the Rumanian Politburo was due to private intrigues of other Rumanian Communist officials who were jealous of Pauker's powers. She is the only female Foreign Minister in the satellites. [ ]
