the 4 Field Army moved several of its units stationed in Central and South China. array dispositions were as follows:

50X1-HUM

- a. The 41 Army: Main forces in the Ch'aochow (116-37, 23-42)-Swatow area. Some units have moved westward and are now stationed near Blas Bay (114-36, 22-40) and Huiyang (114-26, 23-05).
- b. The 43 Army: Main forces on Hainan. Some units in the Ch'inghsien (108-37, 21-58)-Kopu (109-10, 21-38) area.
- c. The 44 Army: Along the Canton-Hankow Railway from Hengyang (122-35, 26-56) to Chuchiang (113-33, 24-50). This army is engaged in a large training program¹.
- d. The 45 Army: This is the main garrison unit for Kwangsi with headquarters at Nanning².
- e. The 46 and 47 Armies: A portion of both armies was sent to Korea last year. The remainder is stationed in Hunan³.
- f. The 49 Army: Transferred to Hankow.
- g. The 51 Army: Transferred from Hankow to Lungchow (106-56, 22-22)⁴.
- h. The 52 and 53 Armies: ten thousand men from both armies were sent to Korea. The remainder are stationed in Kwangsi.
