25X1X 1. [REDACTED] Prague from Bor (N50/P63) via Doly-Tachov-Vitkov-Plana-Marianska Lazne-Karlovy Vary. No undue military activity was observed, contrary to numerous rumors that there is a large shift of personnel to Western Bohemia.

25X1X 2. At Doly, a jeep with one soldier was observed. At Tachov, there did not appear to be any activity around the caserne at the northeastern edge of Tachov. [REDACTED] an obstacle course about three kilometers after the caserne at about 4:30 p.m.; no training was being conducted there. Between Vitkov and Plana, [REDACTED] a truck, full of soldiers with rifles. [REDACTED]
