Wollweber, State Secretary for Transportation, received a secret government order, according to which he was to make preparations for a suspension of interurban railroad traffic in the Western sectors of Berlin on M-day. In order to maintain traffic connections in East Berlin, 300 busses from the Soviet Zone of Germany are to be assembled in Berlin-Ostschoneweide. Erwin Kramer, Director General, Railroads, has not been informed of these plans.
