1. A squadron of bombers is located at the Halborg Military Airfield (C55/D79).
2. Four high-ranking Soviet officers are in command of the air base located in Babie Doly near Gdynia.
3. The military airfield located in Tomaszow Mazowiecki (C52/P31) is being reconstructed. In connection with this, the inhabitants of two of the neighboring villages were forced to move. There are twenty fighters located at this airfield.
4. A military airfield is located in Spala (C52/P41). Underground ammunition and fuel dumps are being constructed in the forests located in the vicinity of the airfield.
