1. In late June 1952, [REDACTED] the chief of the Basa (Central Air Force Commissary) in Werder was Major (Adm) Lavrenchev (fnu). Attached to the Basa were five German stock clerks, five female German accountants, a Soviet chief accountant and two other German employees. Special stock at the Commissary included foodstuffs, cloth including linen, finished goods, footwear, pottery, and miscellaneous goods such as epaulets, [REDACTED] and cameras. Sixty men were employed at the five warehouses of the Basa. The Basa in Werder received its goods from the Brod Basas in Dresden and Teltow. Most of the foodstuffs were delivered by the VEB [REDACTED]

* [REDACTED] Comment. The report [REDACTED] confirms and supplements previous information on this central commissary of the Twenty-Fourth Army in Werder. This agency was previously known as the Petushkov, [REDACTED] Brod Basa means shopping and foodstuff. The term of VEBAB designates the nationalized procurement agency Volkswirtschafts- und Ankaufs-Betrieb.

** [REDACTED] Comment. The data listed on the form indicate that the Basa still served the same supply units as in the fall of 1951. If the men listed on the form, the following were known previously as the chiefs of supply units:

Gutun, chief of the supply unit in Brandenburg;
